Dear Parent/Guardian

As the formal exam season is almost at an end, I would like to share with you how impressed I have been with the majority of Year 11 students in regard to their work ethic during these exams. As the year draws to an end we have some key events to mark the culmination of our Year 11's efforts over the past five years at Park Community School.

Leavers' Assembly - Thursday 22 June - 11am

There will be a Year 11 Leavers' assembly between 11am and 12pm which all Year 11 students are welcome to attend. I would like to remind students that uniform is expected to be worn as it is held at school. The assembly will end with our traditional balloon release.

Prom - Thursday 22 June - 7pm

Our prom is at the Historic Dockyards, Boathouse No.7. The gates at the Dockyards will be open from 6:30pm. It is our hope that all arrivals will be done by 7:30pm so that guests can be sat down for the meal by 7:50pm.

Recent events have led the security levels at the Dockyards to be raised. This now means that transportation is **not allowed to enter the site**. Therefore, arrivals may be a little more complicated as guests will need to be dropped off outside the venue. My advice for those wishing to get pictures involving transport is to try and get them before leaving or arrange a stop off for photos. Time and space will be tight outside the venue as it is a busy road with double yellow lines and bus stops.

The main gate will be closed but we will be able to enter via the small gate on the right hand side. If you wish to enter the site, you will only be allowed to use this gate as the left hand gate will be used for a function on HMS Warrior.

If parents wish to enter the Dockyards you will be able to do so and an area will be allocated where you can take photos opposite Action Stations. This is as far up the walkway non-guests will be allowed. Please be aware that if you do enter the site all bags will be searched. It is advised you do not take one unless absolutely necessary. Students with bags/purses will also be searched before entering the venue.
