Mobile Phones in school

We have noticed an increasing number of students bringing phones into school. Students are not permitted to bring phones onto the school site and this includes use before the school day.

Time at school must be focused on learning and social interactions with peers at breaks. This needs to happen without the distraction of social media.

If you feel your child needs to bring a phone for their journey to school, they are able to do so, but they **MUST** hand their phone into reception when they arrive and collect at the end of the school day. Any communication between a child and their parent during the school day must be through school reception.

We remind you that if a student is seen with a phone, it will be confiscated and put into safekeeping in reception until the end of the school day.

Please support us in ensuring your children do not bring their phones to school.
