

Key Worker Scheme

Terms and conditions:

1. The “Key Worker Scheme” is provided to support the UK Government’s response to the COVID – 19 outbreak and is to provide for “those children who absolutely need to attend”. The vast majority of children should stay home.
2. Parents and carers accept that by enrolling the school will carry out checks to establish their eligibility for this provision. This could include asking to see proof of employment or speaking directly with line managers or others as well as seeking to establish the care options available to any family.
3. The provision is entirely dependent on our own staffing levels. As such, the provision may be reduced, curtailed or removed at short notice.
4. Children attending the school will be required to wear their normal school uniform and observe our current dress and behaviour codes.
5. If a child is unable to attend due to illness, then this will be communicated to the school via the usual routes and in cases of suspected COVID 19 infection, Public Health England advice will be followed and the school informed.
6. As part of our offer, we will be providing a free breakfast club and hot meal. These are subject to availability and there will be limited choice. It may not be possible to stick to any published menus. Every effort will be made to accommodate dietary requirements; however, this is subject to staff and availability.
7. Whilst every effort will be made to provide high quality learning experiences for children. We will not be following the National Curriculum or expecting staff to undertake assessment and feedback. Our principle means to communicate progress and achievement will be through verbal praise from staff.
8. Children who are required to take medication will be supervised by a responsible adult.
9. Parents and carers agree to attendance between 8.30am and 2.45pm unless the school decides otherwise. Entry and exit will generally be through the entrances near the main school reception.
10. We will operate more stringent hygiene protocols including but not limited to regular hand washing with soap and hot water, application of sanitiser and other measures in line with the advice of Public Health England.
