Dear Parents / Carers

Below are the details that we have been provided with by the School Age Immunisation Service regarding the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccinations to Park Community School students. There is also the opportunity to have the first dose if your child has not been able to access one so far.

Please take the time to carefully read the information and consult the supporting documentation which can be accessed using the links contained in the letter.

Please note that the entire process is being run by the Southern Health NHS Foundation and the School Age Immunisation Service, with Park Community School providing the location for the vaccinations. Park Community School has no access to records to show which students have had a first dose of the vaccine, so if you are unsure, please use the email addresses provided below to seek further clarification.

Following the recommendation by the Government, the Southern Health NHS Foundation Trust (SHFT) School Age Immunisation Service (SAIS) will be visiting all secondary schools in Hampshire from 10 January 2022 to deliver the second dose of the COVID-19 vaccination for those who have already received the first dose during the autumn term. For those that missed the opportunity to receive their first dose they can also offer this to your child.

As with the first dose they will be offering a second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine to students in Years 7-11 who are aged 12-15 years on the date they attend the school. If your child received the first COVID-19 vaccination in school and has now turned 16, they will be able to receive their second dose in school. **No vaccines will be administered without valid consent from a parent or carer.**

The School Age Immunisation Service plan to visit Park Community School on **Wednesday 26 January 2022** however this date may change.

E Consent process

For this part of the COVID-19 12-15 programme the School Age Immunisation Service will be using their electronic consent system. All parents, or those with parental responsibility, are asked to give consent and they encourage you to make this decision together with your child and complete the online e-consent form. **Only 1 consent form per child is to be submitted.**

If the person with parental responsibility has not completed the e-consent form, but the child still wishes to receive the vaccination the School Age Immunisation Service will aim to contact you and discuss further options.

The unique code for Park Community School is **SH116473**

Please type this code in when prompted on the e-consent form. Once completed you will receive an email confirmation. This may go into your junk mail folder. If you do not receive a confirmation email, we will be able to confirm whether you have completed and submitted the form.
