Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to you regarding the Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) home learning that your child receives in Years 7, 8 and 9. There are going to be some changes to the setting procedure from 31 October 2022.

These changes are being made in response to feedback and we hope they will make it easier for parents to support with homework and more manageable for students.

The changes are:

- The subjects will be spread more evenly across the fortnight as follows:

Week A MCQs	Week B MCQs
English, Maths, Science, History, RE and Geography	Performing Arts, PE, Design and Technology, Computer Science and Spanish

- You will receive less alerts about homework on Class Charts. Only one notification on Class Charts will be sent, informing you that the week's home learning has been set for the relevant subject.
- If your child misses one or more MCQ quizzes for that week they will be expected to attend a catch-up session on the Wednesday of the following week after school. This will appear as an MCQ recall on Class Charts.
- Merits will be issued as usual on Class Charts for completion of homework, including MCQs.
