







## Free School Meals

From 2 September 2024 the price of a School Meal is increasing to £3.20. We will increase the value of a Free School Meal allowance to £3.20 to match this. This is as a result of the increased cost of providing meals and is a price set by Hampshire County Council. Our lunchtime meal deal will be priced at £3.20 in line with this county-wide change. It remains good value with a main dish, dessert and drink.



A free breakfast subsidised by the school with support through the Magic Breakfast programme is available every day from 8.00am alongside items for sale that are not part of the Magic Breakfast arrangements.

We continue to provide MUNCH meals each Thursday from 4.00pm to 5.30 pm, and our Park Pantry is available to help families. It is supported by Hampshire County Council and a range of food providers and charities. The Pantry is based in our Dickinson Centre and is open Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 11.00am-1.00pm and Wednesday 5.00-7.00pm.

A reminder that a child is eligible for free school meals if their parent or carer receives one or more of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
