## Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach the second half of this half term, I would like to take this opportunity to update you on all things Year 10!

I have thoroughly enjoyed continuing to lead this group of students from last year into this one. Year 10 students have exceeded my expectations in stepping up to the task of GCSE subjects. Our weekly assemblies have been full of good news and a wide range of students have been celebrated for their hard work and efforts. For example, each week English teachers are delivering postcards for me to hand out to students excelling in the GCSE English lessons. 














If your son/daughter would like to attend a club on offer they are free, and no pre-booking is required. Staff look forward to welcoming them. Please see the attached timetable.
