Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers

Year 11 students have now completed their first two weeks of GCSE exams. There are still several important exams to complete after half term - we have English Language paper 2, as well as Maths papers 2 and 3, Science paper 2 and many Options.

To ensure our students are as prepared as possible for the exams, Year 11 students will continue to attend all lessons as normal (when not in exams) for the week after half term.

Where they have lessons for which exams have been completed, they will work independently on revision. Teachers will ensure they have materials for students in these sessions as well as predicted and practice papers to complete. Students are encouraged to bring their own materials with them. It is my belief that this is the best way to guarantee our students are as well prepared for the exams as possible.

From Friday 6 June, after their English exam in the morning, students will only be expected to attend school for lessons for which they have not completed the exams. They will sign in and out on tables by reception.
