Uniform and Equipment - September 2026

Uniform expectations remain the same. All students will be given a brand-new tie on their first day in September in their new year group colour. These will be provided free of charge.

School blazers, school jumpers, PE T-shirt, PE quarter zips and PE hoodies will be available to purchase from school reception until Tuesday, 21 July, and on Tuesday 1 September between 1.00pm and 4.00pm. We have a limited stock in school; once this stock runs out, you will need to purchase items from Skoolkit.

A reminder that if, over the summer, you allow your child to have any facial piercings, false lashes or fake nails, these will need to be removed before they return to school. Hair colour must be returned to natural shades

Pencil cases and equipment: Every student is expected to bring a pencil case to school containing the following equipment: ♦ black pen ♦ green pen ♦ pencil ♦ ruler ♦ protractor ♦ rubber ♦ sharpener.

Students are free to use their Park pencil case or replace it with one of their own. Park pencil cases will be available to purchase for £1.00 from Wednesday, 3 September.

These are part of school uniform and must be brought in everyday if you need to purchase a new one, these can be purchased from reception for £10.

Ready to Learn: Punctuality and Attendance

Attendance: Throughout the year, we have rewarded strong attendance and encouraged students to maintain streaks. From September, continue this. We will support you and your child when attendance is less than 100% through meetings and home visits. Some students struggle to attend school regularly and support is in place to help them.

Punctuality: There are times when there are very good reasons for being late to school and we understand this. However, repeated lateness prevents students having a strong start to the day and also interrupts lessons.

Students arriving within 15 minutes of the bell: The process for a student arriving a few minutes late will remain unchanged. Students arriving late to school within the first 15 minutes of the school day will be escorted to their lesson and set a late recall for the end of the day.

Students arriving 15 minutes or more late for school: Students arriving 15 minutes or more late will be set a one-hour detention after school. If a student arrives after 9.00am their attendance for the morning will be unauthorised.

Activities over the summer include:

- **Munch** - available Monday 27 July until Friday, 21 August 12.00noon - 1.00pm
- **Connect4Youth and Connect4Families** - free activity days and family funs day run throughout the holidays - detailed information can be found at [Connect4Summer - School Holiday Educational Activities](#)
- **GCSE Results Day** - on Thursday, 20 August - students can collect results between 10.00 - 11.00am This applies to our Year 11 leavers and Year 10 students collecting Literature GCSE and vocational option results. Students will also be able to download an app on the day which will create a permanent record of their results for them.

Finally, we would like to thank you for your support this year and wish you and your families a wonderful summer. We are looking forward to the final few weeks of term and final preparation to a strong start on 2 September 2026. We look forward to seeing students back in school on Tuesday, 2 September.
